There are plenty of things to do on this tiny island country, and for starters, you can try out those things which I have mentioned below.

Vallée de Mai

Seychelles is made of three main islands called Mahé, La Digue and Praslin. In Praslin, there is Vallée de Mai, which is a park designated as the UNESCO World Heritage Site. Over here, there is everything you would ordinarily expect in a nature park—but, the manner in which the naturalness has been preserved deserves accolades.

The park is home to much endemic flora and fauna such as the island's palm trees and the island's black parrot. However, in addition to this, you should also consider visiting the Praslin Waterfall, which is just 5 kilometers from the place. You would get a package of wholesome experience of everything in and around the park.

Visit the Capital

Victoria is the capital city of Seychelles and is located on the largest island, Mahé. Incidentally, Victoria is among the smallest capitals in the entire world, but this does not mean that your trip over here will be short of anything.

While the natural scenes will be enough for you to have your fill, your comfort will be looked after by many of its hotels and resorts. However, there is a name which deserves special mention, Eden Bleu, which is the most famous hotel on that island. The hotel is situated right next to the Eden Island mall
